Active Usedom

Discover Usedom in tracking boots or barefoot, equipped with Nordic walking poles or with a traditional walking cane: the island is a true paradise of 445 square kilometres of nearly untouched nature. Extended sandy beaches, impressive steep banks and a vast dune landscape are the landmarks of Usedom. The "Naturpark Insel Usedom" (Island of Usedom Nature Park) presents itself to the visitor in all its facets.

Working out on the Beach. The view of the horizon, the fresh sea air and the special bracing climate invite the visitor to take long walks, to collect sea shells and in some areas even amber. Behind the dunes you find the longest sea front promenade of Europe connecting the Three Imperial Spas Bansin, Heringsdorf and Ahlbeck with Świnoujście (German: Swinemünde) across the German-Polish border. With their magnificent villas these seaside resorts are a living witness of the Resort Architecture style. The impressive mansions in Zinnowitz also tell tales of the imperial age. Beach and promenade invite not only flâneurs but also Nordic walkers and joggers. Even marathon runners and those who wish to train for a marathon find ideal conditions on the Baltic coast of Usedom.

From the Beach to the Usedom Achterland. Those who find beach life too turbulent might prefer Usedom's so called Achterland. The idyllic hinterland with its hidden lanes, quaint fishing villages, woods and flowering salt marshes has lots of preserved nature to offer. Sometimes the Achterland between Achterwasser Lagoon and beach is only a few hundred metres wide. Sometimes it forms peninsulas as the Gnitz or even a surprisingly hilly landscape lovingly called the Usedomer Schweiz (Switzerland of Usedom). The variety of landscape can even surprise experts on the island. The well signposted footpaths of Usedom add up to over 400 kilometres, the cycling trails are 200 kilometres long.

Nature to Taste. The "Island of Usedom Nature Park" was founded in 1999 and comprises the entire island of Usedom, the northern part of the Szczecin Lagoon, the Peenestrom, and the Achterwasser Lagoon, as well as small strips of the mainland on the western bank of the Peenestrom. All in all this cultural landscape covers more than 59,000 hectares. Active holidaymakers can explore the "Island of Usedom Nature Park" all year round under the guidance of rangers. Alternatively they can make use of the custom-tailored round trips offered by private providers. Exploring Usedom by Segway or fishing boat can also be a unique experience.

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The Island by Bicycle. It is, however, quicker and more comfortable to explore the island by bicycle. There are roundabout 200 kilometres of well signposted cycle trails. The network of bicycle rentals with an extensive service package is tight-knit. The service provider UsedomRad alone consists of more than 100 stations on the island and the nearby mainland with more than a 1,000 touring bicycles, children's bicycles and e-cycles for rent. If you exhaust yourself on your trip across the island you can always return your bicycle at the next UsedomRad-station and use public transportation. The Usedomer Bäderbahn (UBB) connects all seaside resorts as far as Świnoujście and runs a well-organized local transport network in the hinterland too.

Galloping along the beach towards the setting sun with the fresh sea air in one's face is a dream for many equestrians. On the island of Usedom this dream can come true. Riding clubs and equestrian farms organize trips on horseback into the endless landscape of the green hinterland of Usedom.
